Mania - 7 Days Hypomania - 4 days

2 Mood Dysfunction = Bipolar Disorder

Bipolar 1 - Experienced (at least once) manic episode

Bipolar 2 - Experiencing hypomanic episodes

Mechanics of Bipolar Disorder

Ventral System - in charge in emotion perception (feeling and labeling the emotions)

Dorsal System - involved in emotion regulation (control, breaks/accelarates emotions)

Childhood Trauma is also a risk factor for bipolar disorder

Managing Bipolar Disorder

Short term solution focuses on the acute manic symptoms

Do not give antidepressants to people with Bipolar Disorder as this will trigger Mania

Long term maintenance focuses on avoiding manic episodes through medication and psychotherapy

Psychotherapy address the symptoms of depression

Psychoeducation aims to make the client become familiar about his/her disorder
