Can we block it? Fibrin / CD11b signaling is required for microglial perivascular clustering and axonal damage

Summary of the working model

BBB disruption & "triggers" for neurologic diseases

5B8 specifically binds the inflammatory form of fibrin

Therapeutic administration of 5B8 reduces neurological symptoms

5B8 does not affect fibrin polymerization or in vivo coagulation
