It is the first installment of her Seasonal quartet—four stand-alone books, separate yet interconnected and cyclical (as the seasons are)—and it casts an eye over our own time. Who are we? What are we made of? Shakespearean *jeu d'esprit*, Keatsian melancholy, the sheer bright energy of 1960s pop art: the centuries cast their eyes over our own history making. Here's where we're living. Here's time at its more contemporaneous and its most cyclic. From the imagination of the peerless Ali Smith comes a shape-shifting series, wide-ranging in time-scale and light-footed through histories, a story about aging and time and love and stories themselves.

### An Autumn Night

August Derleth's greatest literary accomplishment was the creation of an entire community, Sac Prairie, in the heart of his native state of Wisconsin. In tales and novels alike, Derleth continually etched the diverse lives and personalities of the people of Sac Prairie, beginning as early as the 1930s. Although he gathered many of his Sac Prairie stories in several collections, a good many tales remain uncollected. Among them are two lengthy novellas set in the neighboring town of Badger Prairie; one of these, the short novel *The Wife with the Mona Lisa Smile*, is a complex narrative of love and betrayal that has never been reprinted until now. In numerous other tales Derleth addresses religious, domestic, and other conflicts among the denizens of Sac Prairie, focusing on the intricacies of daily life in a way that remains perennially relevant.

Now, the race is on to stop Lucifer from pursuing his plan to seize Father's throne. A dungeon is built to house the lawless, but angels are light-loving entities who will perish in the darkness. A sphere is built to house the leaders of the North. Autumn is at God's side when a bloody altercation ensues between Prince Michael's saints and northern aggressors that results in Lucifer's capture and incarceration. And, she is present when Immanuel is introduced to Heaven's angels. Autumn and the Angel is a faith-based fantasy book that discloses the author's belief that more than Lucifer's desire to rule from God's throne led to his fall from grace. This book is the first installment of Autumn's adventures in Heaven. The second installment, *The Trial of the Great Lucifer*, reveals the result of Heaven's first criminal trial and the events that led to Lucifer's fall to Hell.
