Using race as a heuristic for diagnosis of disease and interpretation of symptoms masks racism. Because of the biological use of race in clinical guidelines and education, patients of color are being systematically misdiagnosed and undertreated, and are at risk for bad health outcomes.

OUR VISION FORWARD (2) In order to account for the health consequences of racism, clinicians should prioritize social history intake and be aware of how social and structural stressors perpetuate racism and racial health inequities.

Healthcare providers play a key role in combating racism. In order to support their patients in feeling happy, healthy, and strong, clinicians must seek to affirm the strengths their patients bring, not assume they are a collection of risk factors. Clinicians need a paradigm shift to approaching patients of color as whole, rather than broken.
