En el mismo sentido, nodescartar otros oficios puede mejorar las posibilidades de firmar un contrato. Las bajas por maternidad, por enfermedad o los contratos de relevo por una jubilación anticipada son una oportunidad para entrar en cualquier empresa. En las zonas turísticas de costa, el número de puestos vacantes se multiplica durante el verano. Muchas ofertas de empleo provienen de las amistades y de los colegas con quienes se ha compartido vida laboral. Es conveniente que quien busca trabajo se lo comunique a sus compañeros y les indique si está abierto a campos en los que

no había estado empleado hasta ahora. Quienes están en activo suelen tener más información sobre los futuros movimientos que habrá en la empresa y podrán alertar a antiguos colegas de posibles vacantes, e incluso, recomendarles para el puesto. Fundar una sociedad o hacerse autónomo es otra manera de conseguir trabajo. Con una idea, un plan de negocio y un capital para sacarlo adelante, el emprendedor puede autoemplearse en un negocio que le guste. Es, eso sí, la más arriesgada de las opciones.

La obra aborda los aspectos teóricos, formales y taxonómicos de la reseña, y ofrece estrategias pedagógicas para su aprendizaje, con la intención de que tenga utilidad para todo tipo de usuario, sea experto o aprendiz, estudiante universitario o, incluso, de secundaria.
