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What the Ten Commandments Means to Me

This book has a very interesting contrast of each of the Ten Commandments. The topics presented are in the categories of why we should follow the commandments. Like why, the benefits, psychological examples, the formation of religions. Included are some personal experiences.

What The Ten Commandments Means To Me

Working in the hospital and prison ministry, I had the opportunity to meet the country's most feared criminal. He was a cult leader with forty churches all around the country. A group of us would go to the prison every Wednesday and were allowed to have church for one hour. God used me to witness to this black, Jewish person who did not believe in Jesus but knew the Old Testament very well. He proclaimed to be their King. With the help of God and my faithful pastor who provided me with scriptures and a book entitles "Concerning Spiritual Gifts" I was able to lead him to the Lord. When he went to the hospital time after time, I was there to visit and pray for him. He experienced God's healing many times even when he was dying from a stroke, enlarged heart, diabetes, and hypertension. He had a miracle and baffled the doctors and nurses. Instead of serving 20 years, he was released after 6 years. There were other prisoners whom god has used me to pray for and they were released too. They all went to church with me. He was baptized 6 months later by the Bishop of the country. We discussed the Ten Commandments and he told me that there is no one who can keep them all. Being a spirit filled Christian on fire for the Lord, I told him, "With the help of the Holy Spirit we can keep them all." This is what inspired me to study and write this book. I come from a Muslim background, my husband from a

Hindu background. I see the idols these religions worship which were made by man's hand. God made man in His image but these people made and continue to make their gods, which THEY turn back and worship (Read Isaiah 44). I tried for fifteen years to finish this book to expose the devil but I never did. I think this is the allotted time. Glory to God!

The Ten Commandments Reconsidered

Do you know the Ten Commandments? Do you know they are still as important as they ever were? The Ten Commandments are a big part of your life, even if you don't think they are. Most of the laws of man are based on the laws handed down from God that are the Ten Commandments. Without the law there is no sin, there is no breaking the law. We have to have something to base our laws on. All modern societies in the world, Christian or not, base most of their laws on these laws from God. Why are more people moving away from God and the laws of God? The problem is that society has started to change them because they don't like the laws that interfere with the things they like to do. Society is getting to the point where anything anyone wants to do is becoming ok. Many people break them and don't even think they are breaking them. It's like speeding in your car. Most people that speed are generally law abiding people that just don't think speeding is breaking the law, but it is against the law. Do you know what the Ten Commandments are? "You shall have no other God before me. (God the creator)" "You shall not make any graven images to worship" "You shall not take the name of the Lord in vain" "Remember the Sabbath day and keep it holy" "Honor your Father and Mother" "You shall not murder" "You shall not commit adultery" "You shall not steal" "You shall not bear false witness (lie)" "You shall not covet your neighbors wife or any of his things" Learn why we need them and why they are very relevant today.

The Ten Commandments

Today is a day of lawlessness. The spirit of our times is one of unbounded "freedom," one of casting off all restraints, despising all authority. Since God Himself is no longer feared by the majority, many no longer respect the God-ordained authority of governments, parents, church leaders, and educators. Because of abounding iniquity on every hand, the love of many professing Christians for their God and His Law has grown cold, just as Christ prophesied (Matthew 24:12). Yet we see in Holy Scripture that the only true freedom is freedom from sin. Concerning the purpose of Christ's coming into the world, God's angel Gabriel said to Joseph, "And thou shalt call His name JESUS (that is, JEHOVAH is Savior): for He shall save His people from their sins" (Matthew 1:21). The Lord Jesus said, "Ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free" (John 8:32). Free from what? Free from sin! Jesus Christ Himself is the Truth, and to know Him is to be free both from the power of reigning sin and from sin's soul-destroying consequences, not simply in the world to come but in this present life as well. The Lord Jesus Himself was well acquainted with the supreme joy of the Godward life of obedience to God's Law and freedom from sin. During His earthly walk, He was a Lawkeeper par excellence. To think, that the Second Person of the holy Trinity, Jehovah the eternal Word, the Lawgiver of Israel, was "made of a woman, made under the Law" (Galatians 4:4) for our redemption! Think on this: the salvation that has been freely given to you, simply by your having trusted in Christ's blood and righteousness, was procured by Him, your substitute, at the highest possible cost. The salvation that is "all of grace" to you was earned, "all of works," by your Savior! And yet He obeyed every commandment with the purest delight, saying, "My meat (food) is to do the will of Him that sent Me, and to finish His work" (John 4:34). Christ could say in the words of Job (23:12), yet with far greater truthfulness, "Neither have I gone back from the commandment of His lips; I have esteemed the words of His mouth more than my necessary food." Mr. Pink's exposition of God's Moral Law is not exhaustive, for that is impossible. The Psalmist says, "I have seen the end of all perfection: but Thy commandment is exceeding broad" (Psalm 119:96). Nevertheless, Mr. Pink gets to the root of man's need. He ably demonstrates the way in which God's Spirit uses the Law: (1) in bringing men to a saving knowledge of Jesus Christ (by bringing them to the end of themselves); and (2) in producing in them an increasing "family resemblance," a holy likeness to their Father in heaven (which is the fruit of true saving faith). If you will read this book prayerfully, then God will graciously enable you to cry out with the Psalmist, "O how love I Thy law! It is my meditation all the day" (Psalm 119:97). Pink (1890-1953) was a Baptist Preacher in England, Australia, and the

United States. He is most famous for his book *The Sovereignty of God*. After its advent, he, assisted by his editor Mr. I. Herendeen, launched his yearly publication, *Studies in the Scriptures* in 1921. These continued until his death, totaling altogether 33 volumes of 288 pp. each. Most of Pink's books are taken from these yearly volumes (written monthly in 24 page format).

For by your words, you will be acquitted, and by your words you will be condemned." (Matthew 12:31, 36, 37) Jesus said to begin praying with: "Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name." (Matthew 6:9) Explanations: Jews and Jewish scribes would go to great measures in order to avoid saying or writing the LORD's name for fear of blasphemy. The Bible says we are to pray, heal, and baptize in Jesus' name. (Matthew 28:19, Mark 16:17, John 14:13, Acts 3:6) The Bible says that what we say is very important and it is a glimpse into who we are (James 3:9-12). God loves us and wants us to love and worship Him in whatever we are doing and at all times. God wants us to use His name; it is holy and powerful. If we can show respect for the names of our fathers, mothers, teachers and doctors, then how much more should we respect the name of our sovereign God. The Ten Commandments

In the contemporary church biblical teaching revolving around the Ten Commandments is inconsistent at best. Paul's statement, misunderstood, is often what Christians will run to, "for ye are not under the law, but under grace," (Rom. 6:14). Christians often want to divorce themselves from God's holiness. They frequently do not understand how holiness in life is attached to both God's character, and God's commandments. Today's church is very happy to take Christ as Savior, in some instances, as prophet, but not so much as King. Christ says, "If a man love me, he will keep my words." The man who loves Jesus as he ought, what will the outcome be for him in this act of loving? "...and my Father will love him, and we will come unto him, and make our abode with him," (John 14:23). Union and communion with Christ are set on keeping his words. The King commands his people and he expects them to obey. This is not legalism, as if one would work for their justification, but rather, it is obedience, that one would be made more like the King in holiness. Christ says, "If ye love me, keep my commandments," (John 14:15). This work takes Christ's Ten Commandments, the commands of King Jesus, and not only expounds their basic teachings, but also how those commands apply to the life of the Christian.
