Technology has compounded the knowledge explosion by making huge quantities of information available with a click of a mouse.

The modern world has created "information overload"

Filtering large quantities of information from the internet requires a new set of skills.

Common core unit activities focus on analyzing and evaluating ideas and checking for supporting evidence.

Under common core, students learn to verify the accuracy of information.
