Place Lid On Top Of The Pan & Cook For The Remainder Of The 45-90 Minutes

Check On The Base Gravy

Use A Hand Blender Or Normal Blender

Boil For A Further 15-20 Minutes

Add 1L Of Boiling Water

125ml Single Cream

Come Back To The Base Gravy When It Gets To A Boiling Point

The purpose of the ALTD is to provide a translation of the Greek New Testament that will enable the reader to come as close to the Greek text as possible without having to be proficient in Greek. The name of the ALTD reflects this purpose. "Literal" refers to the ALTD being a word for word translation.

Any words added for clarity are bracketed. "Analytical" refers to the detailed "analysis" done on the grammar of the text. The grammar is then translated in a way which brings out "nuances" of the original text that are often missed in traditional translations. The volume advances new readings of work by a variety of poets including Walter Scott, Henry Longfellow, William Wordsworth, William Barnes, Walt Whitman, Ralph Waldo Emerson, William Morris, Alfred Tennyson, and Gerard Hopkins.
