Poems, 1965-1975 gathers nearly all of the poems from Seamus Heaney's first four collections: *Death of a Naturalist* (1966), *Door into the Dark* (1969), *Wintering Out* (1972), and *North* (1975).

Poems 1965-1975

Gathered from Margaret Atwood's work over the decade of 1965-1975, *Selected Poems I* is a lasting collection from one of our most celebrated contemporary writers. Margaret Atwood's early poetry garnered widespread critical recognition and helped establish her reputation as one of the most provocative modern literary talents. *Selected Poems I* draws from six collections published early in Atwood's career: *The Circle Game* (1966), which received the Governor General's Award, *The Animals in That Country* (1968), *Procedures for Underground* (1970), *The Journals of Susanna Moodie* (1970), *Power Politics* (1971), and *You Are Happy* (1975). In these early poems, Atwood considers the space between the cruelties of civilization and wonders of nature, the dissonance of Canadian identity, and the line where beauty becomes sinister. With poems that "glisten . . . with terse bright images, untentative, closing like a vise" (*New York Times Book Review*), this is an essential collection to be treasured for years to come.

Selected Poems 1

Originally published in 1969, Seamus Heaney's *Door into the Dark* continues a furrow so startlingly opened in his first collection, *Death of a Naturalist* (1966). With the sensuousness and physicality of language that would become the hallmark of his early writing, these poems graphically depict the

author's rural upbringing, from the local forge to the banks of Lough Neagh, concluding in the preserving waters of the bogland and a look ahead to his next book, *Wintering Out* (1972).

Selected Poems, 1965-1975

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Poems 1965-1975

Barry MacSweeney was born in 1948 and died in 2000. He published numerous collections, including *The Templars of Hazard* and *The Book of Demons*, his last book. It recorded his fierce fight against alcoholism as well as the great love of those who helped save his life--though only for three more years. When he died he had just assembled a retrospective of his work. *Wolf Tongue* is his own selection, with the addition of the last two books that many regard as his finest work, *Pearl* and *The Book of Demons*. Most of his poetry was out-of-print, and much had never been widely published. The title is his. He was a contrary, a lone wolf. His ear for soaring, lyric melody was unmatched, and his poetry became dark as blue steel, edging towards what became his domain: the lament--*The Independent*. His poetry places a radical, critical energy, unsparing of illusions, and bitter and comic in its self-appraisal, at the disposal of a clear-eyed celebration of the world.

Door into the Dark

Selected Poems II

In 2013, Seamus Heaney met with Faber poetry editor Matthew Hollis in Dublin. He said that one project he would very much like to complete would be to prepare a personal selection from across the entire arc of his poetry, small yet comprehensive enough to serve as an introduction for all comers. He never managed to make the selection in his lifetime, and after his passing, the project was initially set aside. But now, at last, it has been returned to once more, and the result is an intimate gathering of poems chosen and introduced by the Heaney family. Coinciding with the opening by the National Library of Ireland of a permanent exhibition dedicated to the life and work of Seamus Heaney, this is a singular, accessible selection for new and younger readers that has the opportunity to reach far and wide, now and ahead.

Wolf Tongue

Death of a Naturalist marked the auspicious debut of poet, Seamus Heaney, with its lyrical and descriptive powers.

Dearly

The Circle Game

Seamus Heaney

100 Poems to Break Your Heart

Spring will marry you. A promise! Cuckoo brings the message: May. O new clothes! O get your house ready! Expectation keeps you starry. But at which church and on what day? In these poems Ted Hughes invites the reader to try and catch the spring (but she's elusive); to take a closer look at the March calf; to listen to the happiness of the summer grass; and to notice the 'weak-neck snowdrops' in winter. Earth is revealed in all its surprising richness and rawness, and so is humankind's own constantly changing relationship with the seasons.

A Late Picking

A new edition of the later selected work of a Nobel Prize-winning poet. Often considered to be "the greatest poet of our age" (The Guardian), Seamus Heaney was awarded the Nobel Prize in Literature in 1995 "for works of lyrical beauty and ethical depth, which exalt everyday miracles and the living past." He saw poetry as a vocation and credited it with "the power to persuade the vulnerable part of our consciousness of its rightness in spite of the evidence of wrongness all around it, the power to remind us that we are hunters and gatherers of values." Paul Muldoon wrote that Heaney was "the only poet I can think of who was recognized worldwide as having moral as well as literary authority." Shortly before his death in 2013, Seamus Heaney began to compile *Selected Poems 1988–2013*, and although he was unable to complete the project, his choices have been followed here. This volume encapsulates the finest work from *Seeing Things* (1991) with its lines of loss and revelation; *The Spirit Level* (1996) where we experience "the poem as ploughshare that turns time / Up and over."; the landmark translation of *Beowulf* (1999); *Electric Light* (2001), a book of origins and oracles; and his final collections, *District and Circle* (2006) and *Human Chain* (2010), which limn the interconnectedness of being, our lifelines to our inherited past.

The Sandpipers

Occupying the same childhood landscapes that may be familiar to English-language readers from the previously published volume *The History of Violets* (Ugly Duckling Presse, 2010), these serial prose poems explore memory, familial relationships, erotic desire, and war. Marosa di Giorgio uses the recurring setting of a garden as a stage for the ongoing encounter of nature and the supernatural.

The Cambridge Companion to Seamus Heaney

A major poet in English, Kamala Das's taboo-breaking work explores themes of love and betrayal, the corporeal and the spiritual, while celebrating female sexuality and remaining deeply rooted in the poet's ancestral tradition and landscape. A rigorous selection from her oeuvre—six published volumes and other uncollected and previously unpublished poems—this edition offers a unified perspective on her

poetic achievement. An illuminating introduction to her poetry by Devindra Kohli traces the sources of its ferment, and showcases its originality of style and its acts of resistance.

Bombs

In a momentous publication, Seamus Heaney's translation of Book VI of the Aeneid, Virgil's epic poem composed sometime between 29 and 19 BC, follows the hero, Aeneas, on his descent into the underworld. In *Stepping Stones*, a book of interviews conducted by Dennis O'Driscoll, Heaney acknowledged the importance of the poem to his writing, noting that 'there's one Virgilian journey that has indeed been a constant presence, and that is Aeneas's venture into the underworld. The motifs in Book VI have been in my head for years - the golden bough, Charon's barge, the quest to meet the shade of the father.' In this new translation, Heaney employs the same deft handling of the original combined with the immediacy of language and flawless poetic voice as was on show in his translation of *Beowulf*, a reimagining which, in the words of Bernard O'Donoghue, brought the ancient poem back to life in 'a miraculous mix of the poem's original spirit and Heaney's voice'.

The Poems of St. John of the Cross

Widely and justly celebrated for his flawless handling of the lyric, Seamus Heaney is here shown venturing into new imaginative territory.
