I Rode Ahead of the Command About Ten Mars and Mounting a Hill I Scanned the Country Far and Wide with Mud Filled Glass and Discovered a Column of Dust Rising About Ten Miles Farther down the Creek and Soon I Noticed a Body of Men Marching toward Me that at First I Believed To Be Indians of Whom We Were in Pursuit but Subsequently They Proved To Be General Terrorists C'mon I Sent Back Vert to Data Fact to General Kruk by a Scout Who Had Accompanied Me but after He Had Departed I Observed a Band of Indians on the Opposite Side of the Creek

And Not Be Detained by a Vagon Train or Heavy Luggage of any Kind that Evening General Terry Ordered General Myers To Take His Regiment Two-Fifths Infantry and Returned by a Forced March to Yellowstone and Proceeded down the River by Steamboat to the Mouth of the Powder River To Intercept the Indians in Case They Attempted To Cross the Yellowstone General Miles Made a Forced March that Night of 35 Miles Which Was Splendid Traveling for an Infantry Regiment through a Mountainous Country General Crook and Terry Spent that Evening and the Next Day in Council

and on a Following Morning both Commands Moved Out on the Indian Trail Although They Operated Together We Crossed the Tong River to Powder River and Proceeded Down the Letter Stream to a Point 20 Miles from Its Junction with Yellowstone Where the Indian Tre Turned to the Southeast in the Direction of the Black Hills the Two Commands Now Being Nearly out of Supplies the Trail Was Abandoned and the Troops Kept On down Powder River to Its Confluence with Yellowstone and Remained There Several Days Here We Met General Myers Who Reported that no Indians Had As Yet Crossed the Yellowstone Several Steamboats Soon Arrived with a Large Quantity of Supplies and Once More the Boys in Blue Were Made Happy Fun Evening while Vivir Encamped on the Yellowstone

I Finally Consented To Go and Was Soon Speeding over the Rough and Hilly Country toward Powder River and Delivered the Dispatches to General Terry the Same Evening General Visitors Halls although a Good Animal Was Not Used to Such Hard Riding and Was Far More Exhausted by the Journey than I Was after I Had Taken a Lunch General Terry Asked Me if I Would Carry some Dispatches Back to General Whistler and I Replied that I Would Captain Smith's General Terry's Ada Com Offered Me His Horse for the Trip and It Proved To Be an Excellent Animal for I Wrote Him that Same Night Forty Miles over the Badlands

It Was Two O'clock in the Morning When I Left a Boat and at Eight O'clock I Rode into General Terrorists Camp Just as He Was About To March Having Made 120 Miles in Twenty-Two Hours

General Terry after Reading the Dispatches Halted His Command and Then Rode On and Overtook General Crook with Whom He Held a Council the Result Was that Crooks Command Moved On in the Direction Which They Had Been Pursuing but Terry's Forces Marched Back to Yellowstone and Crossed the River on Steamboats at the Urgent Request of General Terry I Accompanied the Command on a Scout in the Direction of the Drive Fork of the Missouri

Captain Frederick Marryat (10 July 1792 - 9 August 1848) was a British Royal Navy officer, a novelist, and an acquaintance of Charles Dickens. He is noted today as an early pioneer of the sea story, particularly for his semi-autobiographical novel *Mr Midshipman Easy* (1836), for his children's novel *The Children of the New Forest* (1847), and for a widely used system of maritime flag signalling, known as Marryat's Code. Early life and naval career: Marryat was born in Great George Street, Westminster, London, the son of Joseph Marryat (1757-1824), a "merchant prince" and member of Parliament, and his American wife Charlotte, née von Geyer. After trying to run away to sea several times, Marryat was permitted to enter the Royal Navy in 1806 as a midshipman on board HMS *Imperieuse*, a frigate commanded by Lord Cochrane (who later served as inspiration for Marryat as well as other authors). Marryat's time aboard the *Imperieuse* included action off the Gironde, the rescue of a fellow midshipman who had fallen overboard, captures of many ships off the Mediterranean coast of Spain, and the capture of the castle of Montgat. The *Imperieuse* shifted to operations in the Scheldt in 1809, where Marryat contracted malaria; he returned to England on the 74-gun HMS *Victorious*. After recuperating, Marryat returned to the Mediterranean in the 74-gun HMS *Centaur* and again saved a shipmate by leaping into the sea after him. He then sailed as a passenger to Bermuda in the 64-gun HMS *Atlas*, and from there to Halifax, Nova Scotia on the schooner HMS *Chubb*, where he joined the 32-gun frigate HMS *Aeolus* on 27 April 1811. A few months later, Marryat again earned distinction by leading the effort to cut away the *Aeolus*'s mainyard to save the ship during a storm and, continuing a pattern, he also saved one of the men from the sea. Shortly thereafter, he moved to the frigate HMS *Spartan*, participating in the capture of a number of American ships (the War of 1812 having begun). On 26 December 1812, he was promoted to lieutenant, and as such served in the sloop HMS *Espiegle* and in HMS *Newcastle*. Marryat led four barges from the latter ship on a punishing raid to Orleans, Massachusetts on December 19, 1814, the last combat in New England during the war. The affair had mixed results.
