let it marinate on high heat for about 6 to 12

mix this in with the sand  
got the crucible here heating inside the furnace  
tap the crucible a few times  
turned sand into glass  
attempted to blow some of the led glass  
let it marinate for almost 7 hours  
reach down into the crucible with a steel rod  
baking along in the kiln
