MAT uses certain medications in combination with counseling & behavioral therapies.

C.B.T. has been shown to be an effective treatment for various mental health conditions

Helps people cope with life stressors, such as relationship problems or job loss.

Counseling can also help people make positive changes, such as quitting substance use or losing weight.

Family Treatment Approaches involve working with the addict's family to address the underlying issues contributing to the addiction.
