A disciple is a follower of Jesus Christ. Disciples of Jesus are to be growing to become more like Him. Existing disciples are the instruments God has chosen to be making new disciples. More mature disciples are the instruments God has chosen to teach less mature disciples. The task of making disciples is the purpose of the church. In many ways the task of making disciples comprises the scope of, the Christian Church. Each and every follower of Jesus is to have making disciples as clearly in focus in every aspect of life. But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be My witnesses both in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and even to the remotest part of the earth." Acts 1:8 This book is a tool to equip existing Christian disciples to easily and effectively communicate some basic truths foundational to every new follower of Jesus. What is in this book? The book contains 10 chapters/lessons with each chapter containing two sections. 1) The first section in each chapter, the bulk of material is a lesson plan/guide for the teacher. 2) The second section is fill-in-the-blank handout for the student. The topics have been selected assuming that the person being taught has expressed faith in Jesus for salvation but has little, if any, Bible knowledge. Each lesson addresses foundational Biblical truth essential to the vigorous growth every follower Jesus. Each lesson is also designed to provide encouragement for even the most mature believer as they share the cherished truths. Thus, upon completing each lesson both the teacher and the student will find themselves refreshed and stimulated in their faith.
