It Was a Good Plan!

Jeffrey Record has specialized in investigating the causes of war. In *The Specter of Munich: Reconsidering the Lessons of Appeasing Hitler* (Potomac Books, Inc., 2006), he contended that Hitler could not have been deterred from going to war by any action the Allies could plausibly have taken. In *Beating Goliath: Why Insurgencies Win* (Potomac Books, Inc., 2007), Record reviewed eleven insurgencies and evaluated the reasons for their success or failure, including the insurgents' stronger will to prevail. *Wanting War: Why the Bush Administration Invaded Iraq* (Potomac Books, Inc., 2009) includes one of Record's most cogent explanations of why an often uncritical belief in one's own victory is frequently (but not always) a critical component of the decision to make war. Record incorporates the lessons of these earlier books in his latest, *A War It Was Always Going to Lose: Why Japan Attacked America in 1941*. The attack on Pearl Harbor is one of the most perplexing cases in living memory of a weaker power seeming to believe that it could vanquish a clearly superior force. On closer inspection, however, Record finds that Japan did not believe it could win; yet, the Japanese imperial command decided to attack the United States anyway. Conventional explanations that Japan's leaders were criminally stupid, wildly deluded, or just plumb crazy don't fully answer all our questions, Record finds. Instead, he argues, the Japanese were driven by an insatiable appetite for national glory and economic security via the conquest of East Asia. The scope of their ambitions and their fear of economic destruction overwhelmed their knowledge that the likelihood of winning was slim and propelled them into a war they were always going to lose.

A War It Was Always Going to Lose

In 1973, Henry Kissinger shared the Nobel Peace Prize for the secret negotiations that led to the Agreement on Ending the War and Restoring Peace in Vietnam. Nixon famously declared the 1973 agreement to be “peace with honor”; America was disengaging, yet South Vietnam still stood to fight its own war. Kissinger promptly moved to seal up his personal records of the negotiations, arguing that they are private, not government, records, and that he will only allow them to be unsealed after his death. *No Peace, No Honor* deploys extraordinary documentary bombshells, including a complete North Vietnamese account of the secret talks, to blow the lid off the true story of the peace process. Neither Nixon and Kissinger’s critics, nor their defenders, have guessed at the full truth: the entire peace negotiation was a sham. Nixon did not plan to exit Vietnam, but he knew that in order to continue bombing without a congressional cutoff, he would need a fig leaf. Kissinger negotiated a deal that he and Nixon expected the North to violate. Ironically, their long-maintained spin on what happened next is partially true: only Watergate stopped America from sending the bombers back in. This revelatory book has many other surprises. Berman produces new evidence that finally proves a long-suspected connection between candidate Nixon in 1968 and the South Vietnamese government. He tells the full story of Operation Duck Hook, a large-scale offensive planned by Nixon as early as 1969 that would have widened the war even to the point of bombing civilian food supplies. He reveals transcripts of candidate George McGovern’s attempts to negotiate his own October surprise for 1972, and a seriocomic plan by the CIA to overthrow South Vietnam’s President Thieu even as late as 1975. Throughout, with page-turning dialogue provided by official transcriptions and notes, Berman reveals the step-by-step betrayal of South Vietnam that started with a short-circuited negotiations loop, and ended with double-talk, false promises, and outright abandonment. Berman draws on hundreds of declassified documents, including the notes of Kissinger’s aides, phone taps of the Nixon campaign in 1968, and McGovern’s own transcripts of his negotiations with North Vietnam. He has been able to double- and triple-check North Vietnamese accounts against American notes of meetings, as well as previously released bits of the record. He has interviewed many key players, including high-level South Vietnamese officials. This definitive account forever and completely rewrites the final chapter of the Vietnam war. Henry Kissinger’s Nobel Prize was won at the cost of America’s honor.

Das Handbuch präsentiert die Kontexte, in denen Kafka stand und stellt sein Leben sowie die wichtigsten Werke, Fragmente, Tagebücher und Briefe vor. Dabei wird deutlich, welchen Einfluss z. B. der Prager Kreis, Judentum/Zionismus, Philosophie, Psychoanalyse, Film und Fotografie auf Kafkas Texte hatten. Besonderer Wert wird erstmals auf die Entwicklungsgeschichte des Kafka schen Werkes gelegt.

Gregor Samsa wacht eines Morgens auf und stellt fest, dass er "zu einem ungeheueren Ungeziefer verwandelt" wurde. Er hält diese Verwandlung anfangs nur für vorübergehend und stellt sich erst langsam den verschiedenen Konsequenzen seiner unfreiwilligen Metamorphose. Zunächst unfähig aufzustehen und das Bett zu verlassen, reflektiert Gregor über seinen Beruf als Handelsreisender und Tuchhändler: Die auszehrende Tätigkeit, von einem "nie herzlich werdenden menschlichen Verkehr" gekennzeichnet, nimmt ihn völlig in Anspruch. Wäre er nicht alleiniger Familienernährer, der die Schulden seines bankrottgegangenen Vaters abarbeiten muss, würde er augenblicklich kündigen und dem despotischen Arbeitgeber "vom Grunde seines Herzens aus" die Meinung sagen. So aber ist er in anscheinend unüberwindbare ökonomische Abhängigkeitsverhältnisse verstrickt. Franz Kafka (1883-1924) war ein deutschsprachiger Schriftsteller. Sein Hauptwerk bilden neben drei Romanfragmenten (Der Process, Das Schloss und Der Verschollene) zahlreiche Erzählungen.

Welche Stellung haben die einzelnen Warengruppen im Buchmarkt allgemein und speziell im Sortimentsbuchhandel? Entwicklungstendenzen jeder einzelnen Warengruppe? Wie kann die betreffende Warengruppe optimal vermarktet und vorteilhaft im Ladengeschäft präsentiert werden? Welches sind die führenden Verlage und wichtigen Reihen für die jeweilige Warengruppe?

Deutsche Nationalbibliographie und Bibliographie der im Ausland erschienenen deutschsprachigen Veröffentlichungen

Der deutsche 'Erzhumanist' Konrad Celtis (1459--1508) ist einer der großen Archegeten der neueren deutschen Literaturgeschichte. Durch seine lyrischen Zyklen (Oden, Elegien, Epigramme) wie durch seinen lebenslangen Einsatz für die studia humanitatis wird der erste gekrönte Dichter auf deutschem Boden zur Schlüsselfigur des Humanismus nördlich der Alpen. Ein Jahrhundert vor Opitz unternimmt er den wegweisenden Versuch, im Anschluß an Tendenzen des italienischen Humanismus antike Gattungen, Diskurse und Geselligkeitsformen systematisch in die deutsche Literatur einzuführen. So ist Celtis nicht nur Autor der ersten humanistischen Poetik (»Ars versificandi et carminum«), er legt mit den »Amores« (Nürnberg 1502) auch den ersten bedeutenden Zyklus neulateinischer Dichtung in Deutschland vor, dessen Initialwirkung für die Folgezeit kaum zu überschätzen ist. Ziel der Studie ist es, Celtis' Projekt einer deutschen Dichtung lateinischer Sprache umfassend vor seinem geistes- und literarhistorischen Horizont nachzuzeichnen. Von der »Ars versificandi« über die Ingolstädter Rede bis zu den »Amores« werden dabei erstmals alle bedeutenden Texte und Bilddokumente in einer systematischen, diskursorientierten Monographie erfaßt. In ihrem Mittelpunkt steht der große Zyklus von Liebeselegien (»Amores«), der nach seinen wichtigsten Aspekten (Gattungsfragen, Nationaldiskurs, lyrische Selbstdarstellung) untersucht wird. Auf diese Weise zeichnen sich Konturen eines Werkes ab, das als Gründungsdokument der neueren deutschen Literatur gelten kann.

Ein Schatz wird gehoben: Die schönsten, bedeutendsten und überraschendsten Briefwechsel zwischen Carl Seelig und den Größen der deutschsprachigen Literatur sind hier zum ersten Mal versammelt. Sie zeigen Seelig als einsamen Studenten, der sich von Carl Spitteler Trost erhofft. Als begeisterten Leser, der im Ersten Weltkrieg Bücher an Hermann Hesse in die »Bücherzentrale für deutsche Kriegsgefangene« schickt. Als beherzten Herausgeber, der von Stefan Zweig beraten wird und von Franz Kafka eine Abfuhr erhält. Als engagierten Förderer der Exilierten, der Nelly Sachs einen Verlag sucht, für Alfred Polgar Geld auftreibt und Thomas Mann zu dessen Erstaunen Hilfe anbietet, statt ihn um Hilfe zu bitten. Carl Seelig war ein außerordentlicher Netzwerker. Als Vermittler zwischen Schreibenden, Verlagen und Zeitungen half er denjenigen weiterzuarbeiten, die der Nationalsozialismus zum Schweigen bringen wollte. In seinen Briefwechseln wird er als Anwalt einer bedrohten Literatur erfahrbar.
