Hiro Onoda was an Imperial Japanese Army intelligence officer who fought in World War II.

Onoda was born on March 19, 1922, in Kamekawa Village, Kaiso District, Wakayama Prefecture, Japan.

He belonged to a family of warrior class ancient samurai.

When he was 18, he was enlisted in the Imperial Japanese Army Infantry.

On December 26, 1944 he was sent to Lubang Island in the Philippines to join the Sugi Brigade. The surrender of Imperial Japan was announced on August 15 and formally signed on September 2, 1945.

The first time they saw & leaflet announcing that Japan had surrendered was in October 1945. By the end of 1945. General Tomoyuki Yamashita of the 14th Area Army issued a surrender order which was dropped from the skies.

In 1952 letters and family pictures were dropped from aircraft urging them to surrender.

Onoda spent 29 years holding out in the Philippines eating coconuts, bananas, and stolen livestock On February 20, 1974 Norio Suzuki found Onoda but he still refused to surrender

Taniguchi flew back to Lubang and formally relieved Onoda of his duty on March 9, 1974 - 29 years after WWII ended.

Only then did he surrender and return home to spend the rest of life in Japan.

On his return to Japan Onoda set up a survival-training school for children, hoping to toughen them up

He died on January 16 2014 aged 94.
