 Intrinsic Physiologic Reserves and Resilience Evolve with Aging
 Formalized phenotype or clinical presentation: Identification of the clinical syndrome of frailty Multiple (3-5/5) criteria present = frail
 Operationalization of Frailty Phenotype in Cardiovascular Health Study
 Frailty prevalence increases with age and differs by gender: 3 criteria present, CHS
 Frailty phenotype is consistent with definition of a clinical syndrome
 Frailty: A Clinical Syndrome
 Frailty syndrome is chronic and progressive
 Phenotype of Frailty associated with dysregulation/deficits of multiple physiologic functional or regulatory systems
 Associations of the Number of Physiologic Systems at Abnormal Levels with Frailty (WHAS II)
 Implications: Frailty is a complex system problem
 Frailty syndrome: associated with threshold severity of multisystem dysregulation
 Frailty Syndrome: Dysregulation of Multiple Physiologic and Molecular Systems Clinical presentation emerges past a threshold of severity of physiologic decrements -Loss: of physiological networking and mutual regulation
 Principles of nonlinear complex dynamical systems are evidenced in frailty syndrome
 Frailty: potential clinical applications and future challenges
 Identification of Frailty syndrome and physiologic precursors will enable
