Who should be tested for Zika virus infection - Patient with fever, rash, arthralgia, or conjunctivitis - Onset during or within 2 weeks of travel to an area with ongoing

Prenatal Zika Virus Infection and Pregnancy Outcomes - Possible adverse reproductive outcomes due to congenital Zika infection - Fetal death - early and late pregnancy loss

Congenital Zika Syndrome - Cranial Morphology • Severe microcephaly (most greater than 3 SD below the mean) Partial collapse of the skull with overlapping sutures

Fetal Brain Disruption Sequence . First described in 1984 by Russell et al. but noted in report from 1836 • Brain destruction resulting in collapse of the fetal skull, microcephaly, scalp rugae, and neurologic impairment . Consequence of decreased intracranial pressure due to infection, vascular disruption, fever Images below from a 1990 series

Congenital Zika Syndrome - Other Neurologic Sequelae • Information on long term medical and developmental outcomes or mortality sparse Neurologic sequelae reported to date in addition to contractures include the following
