Professional Development and Workplace Learning

Professional Development and Workplace Learning

And Part IV focuses on the training of the instructors, visiting the three key themes of relationships, activities or tasks, and work practices.

The first group is mainly interested in the question of how learning comes about; the second group is predominantly interested in the search for factors affecting learning.
