Diagnostic Statement a 5-year-old male who is exhibiting low average receptive language skills, severe impairment in expressive language, and a severe impairment in speech acquisition, due primarily to difficulty with planning and programming movement gestures for speech production (CAS). There is no frank evidence for dysarthria. He is pragmatically and socially appropriate, focuses attention well, and attempts all tasks.
