La mujer en silencio

Sylvia Plath has been one of the great literary figures of the twentieth century, whose work has not yet exhausted the inspiration of her readers. But behind the appearance of the beautiful, blonde American

housewife, with which the poet liked to present herself in her most successful years, are hidden the tragic and problematic features of a fragile, passionate and ambitious woman, who does not easily integrate into her myth. Separated from her husband Ted Hughes, she committed suicide out of jealousy at the age of 30. To the fame of her poems was added the notoriety of the tragedy, which tempted many to write their versions of the story. Janet Malcolm interrogates various people who once had something to do with Sylvia Plath to reconstruct the plot of memories and speculations. With her excellent narrative style, the author unmasks the indiscretion, the lust for scandal and half-truths about the poet and her marriage, her encounters with Plath's biographers, the strange manipulation of her legacy, jealously guarded by her husband, all in a critical and brilliant lesson on biography as a literary genre, which one would say leads to a new genre: A metabiography, constructed as a subtle weaving of fragments of poems, letters, stories and dialogues, which reveals a Sylvia Plath totally different from the one we have been introduced to so far.

Legacy," reconsiders her personal views on creative writing and her wishes regarding the handling of her estate upon death. With these final essays, the collection comes full circle, attesting to the hazards that come from overly relying on O'Connor's interpretation of her own work but also from ignoring her views and desires. Through these reconsiderations, some of which draw on previously unpublished archival material, the collection attests to and promotes the vitality of scholarship on Flannery O'Connor.

Women in Dark Times

In 1843 on the island of Tahiti the evangelical missionary Rev. Alexander Simpson was accused of sexually assaulting three of the female students under his care, and of taking 'improper liberties' with at least three more. The events did not come out in public for at least a decade, while Simpson's power in the local community only grew and rumblings relating to his wrong-doings were ruthlessly 'crushed'. By exploring the case of Rev. Simpson, Emily Manktelow gives us key insights into the gender, power and racial dynamics of a particular case of sexual abuse on the frontiers of European colonialism. Between the Sheets

'Assia was my true wife, and the best friend I ever had', wrote Ted Hughes, after his lover surrendered her life and that of their young daughter in 1969, six years after Sylvia Plath had suffered a similiar fate. Diva, she-devil, enchantress, muse, Lillith, Jezebel - Assia inspired many epithets during her life. The tragic story of Sylvia Plath and Ted Hughes has always been related from one of two points of view: hers or his. Missing for over four decades had been a third: that of Hughes's mistress. This first biography of Assia Wevill views afresh the Plath-Hughes relationship and at the same time, recounts the journey that shaped her life. Wevill's is a complex story, formed as it is by the pull of often contrary forces.

Sylvia Plath

In 1961, psychiatrist Eric Berne published a book with a very boring title, Transactional Analysis in Psychotherapy. It became the foundation work in its field, much referenced, and was a reasonable seller. Three years later he published a sequel based on the same concepts but with a more colloquial feel. With its brilliant title and witty, amusing categories of human motivation, Games People Play was bound to attract more attention.
