They control when and where in the body a gene is switched on, and how much protein is made from it.

This is all coordinated through a network of proteins and other molecules that interact with these switches.

And finding meaningful changes among all the neutral ones is like searching for a needle in a haystack

Modern humans have unique methylation patterns around hundreds of genes.

And it appears to enhance the activity of another gene specifically in the neocortex, an area involved in higher brain functions.

They should be able to use gene editing to see what happens to cells or organoids when you change individual DNA sequences.
