Our map, now reproduced, was published in the Proceedings of the Royal Geographical Society for March, 1889, and it has been to me no small gratification to receive letters from travellers in Canada, the United States, and at home, men not previously known to me, saying that they found it useful, and that it helped them to enjoy the scenery of the Selkirks during the past summer. Though all the time at our disposal was devoted to rendering our map as accurate as possible, more careful surveys will find many corrections necessary in detail. Driven by a love of glaciers and a need to see them before they disappear, Garrett Fisher piloted his 1949 antique airplane across the mountains of Colorado, Wyoming, and Montana, photographing remaining glaciers in the American Rockies. From Rocky Mountain National Park to the Wind River Range, Grand Teton National Park, Yellowstone, and Glacier National Park, the Rockies contain a surprising number of glaciers tucked away in wilderness areas...that is, until they are gone. Scientists predict that many of these treasures will disappear not only in our lifetimes, but in the near future. A feat of aviation, Mr. Fisher gets up close and personal with glaciers glued to the sides of rocky summits, flying as high as 15,000 feet while getting buffeted by strong winds and extreme cold, all the while hoping the propeller would keep spinning, as many of these mountain ranges were in wilderness bear country. His airplane lacks heat, weighs less than 800 pounds, and produces 100 horsepower on a good day. Containing 177 aerial images, the book is organized by mountain range, with detailed maps identifying the location of each photograph. With images ranging from scenic landscapes to detailed zooms of glacial texture, the work appeals to hikers, scientists, or anyone who loves the great outdoors.

Glaciers adjust their physical properties to changes in climate, but long records of glacier change needed to examine this relation are spatially and temporally limited. I determined changes in glacier area in the central and southern Canadian Rocky Mountains and changes in length, area, elevation, and volume of the Columbia Icefield over the past nine decades. I used Interprovincial Boundary Commission Survey (IBCS) maps of the Alberta-British Columbia (BC) border (1903-1924), aerial photographs (1948-1993), BC Terrain Resource Information Management (TRIM) data (1982-1987), and satellite imagery (1999-2009) in my analysis. From 1919-2006, total glacierized area in the Canadian Rocky Mountains decreased by $590 \pm 100 \text{ km2}$ ($40 \pm 7\%$); glaciers smaller than 1.0 km2 experienced the greatest percentage loss. Slope and minimum elevation are negatively correlated with absolute area loss, and mean and median elevations are negatively correlated with relative area loss. From 1919-2009, glaciers of the Columbia Icefield retreated 1149.9 \pm 34.1 m, decreased 59.60 \pm 1.19 km2 (22.5 \pm 5.0%), thinned 49.4 \pm 25.2 m w.e., and lost 14.30 \pm 2.02 km3 w.e. Debris-covered ice thinned 30-60% less than bare ice. Changes in temperature and precipitation explain some of the observed changes. I detected a lag of two to ten years between climate and glacier response.
