Set the Stage for Process Improvement: This step starts with creating the environment. In this context, the improvement team needs to be selected and trained by improvement tools. Mission statement and quality issues need to be discussed. Setting the ground rules and logistics are also topics about this step.

Select a Process to Improve: This step starts with identifying, prioritizing and selecting the opportunities. After localizing the problem, an improvement plan needs to be created. After establishing operational definitions and team objectives, key measures are identified.

Tighten the Process: To assess the process capability against requirements, the process needs to be streamlined and error-proofed. The work area should be straightened-up and unnecessary equipment should be eliminated. To institute total productive maintenance, to document lessons learned and to collect and maintain process performance data are the other issues in this step.

CONCEPTUAL FRAMEWORK OF CONTINUOUS IMPROVEMENT Step 6: Improve the Process: This step is shortly described in four stages: (POCA): Plan (P)-Do (D)-Check (C)-Act (A). The "Plan" stage starts with developing questions and a theory. After analyzing available process data and stating a goal, a change or test needs to be planned. To design system changes, to define expected outcomes, to identify process measures, to plan data collection strategy, to establish a test

Assess Improvement Performance: In the last step data is organized and project results are documented in picture book format. After making final presentations, team methods and project results are evaluated.

The study involved a survey of 92 professional and regulatory bodies, in-depth interviews with group representatives, discussions at a seminar, and a review of the literature. The research revealed that: (1) PRBs are varied in organization, scope, power and involvement in their field, which is reflected in a wide range of types of involvement in higher education; (2) the professional-client relationship is one of a power imbalance brought about by the professional's knowledge and ability and the client's needs (although professional values supposedly proscribe the exploitation of this relationship); (3) the professional body is entrusted with ensuring the public interest in the absence of any effective checks on the activities of the professional through the operation of the market; and (4) although professional bodies vary enormously in their requirements, there is a broad tendency among many professions for a distinction between initial education and professional training. The study also led to a series of recommendations such as that professional bodies should define the specific competencies and underpinning knowledge required of their practitioners and the trend toward indirect monitoring of standards should be encouraged.
