A drawing is made

in a mordant bath

ready to be charged with ink.

placed onto a hot plate, a heated plate

Ink is evenly...

dragged across the surface of the plate

The ink is then cleaned from the surface of the plate

The plate is then moved to a press

and transferred to the paper.

Usually this is done with some kind of registration template

Prior to printing

This paper is then transferred to the press
placed on top of the etching plate...

Pressure is applied

You'll notice that this print prints as a mirror of the drawing.

The plate is then re-inked

and subsequent prints are taken

This is usually referred to as an "edition".
