It Was Designed by Many White Men Who Didn't Own Slaves but Who Felt They Had To Compromise with those Who Did and It Included Provisions in Terms of the Constitution of the United States That Determined that Slaves Were Three-Fifths of a Person for the Purpose of Representation Which Was Not Simply an Effort To Stigmatize Slaves or Black People as Saying They Were Less than Human It Was an Effort To Award Additional Representation to the Slave Owners because the Three-Fifths of a Person Meant that Slaves Could Be Counted in the Apportionment of Districts

So I'm Making this Analogy to the Canary and the Mines because the Miners Used To Take a Canary

into the Coal Mines To Alert Them When the Atmosphere in the Mines Was Too Toxic for the Miners and the Canary Was More Fragile It Had a Respiratory System That Was Weaker More Vulnerable and So When the Canary Started To Gasp for Breath That Was a Sign that the Miners Needed To Leave the Mine Not that the Canary Was Somehow Inadequate the Way in Which We Tend To Think about Issues of Race or Issues of Gender Is To See the Canary Gasping for Breath as a Sign that There Is a Problem with the Canary

So You Could Be Represented by Somebody That You Voted against or You Could Be Represented by Somebody that if You Had Had the Chance To Vote for Them You Would Have Now I Want To Argue that There Is Something Flawed in that Concept of Representation because Number One It Puts Too Much Weight on the Moment of Choice That Is the Election To Determine What Your Relationship Is with a Particular Representative and that Moment of Choice I Would Argue Is Corrupted by the Fact that in Legislative Bodies in Particular the People Who Are Terminating that Choice for You That Is the People Who Are Drawing Your Districts Are the People Who Are Themselves Invested in a District That Is Going To Be Composed of People Most Likely To Vote for Them

But I Also Want To Suggest that There Is Something Wrong with that Concept because Representation in My View Is a Relationship It Is Not Simply a Moment of Choice Representation Is a Relationship It Is an Ongoing Relationship and It Is Not Simply a Relationship between the Voter and the Person He or She Voted for It Is Also a Horizontal Relationship among the Constituents among the People Who Are Being Represented because in Many Ways the Only Way You Can Hold a Representative Accountable to Your Ideals to Your Hopes or to Your Articulated Interests Is if You Create a Constituency of Accountability That Continues To Exist after the Election and that Is Part of the Reason That We Have Such a Conflict in Our System about the Role That Lobbyists

They Were in a Position To Ascend the Ladder of Personal Success and Then They Could Rationalize that by Saying that They Were Actually Helping Their Constituents Even though They Were Voting against the Interests of Their Constituents They Were Helping Their Constituents because When They Became More Important They Would Be in a Better Position To Represent Their Constituents but of Course if Their Focus Is on Their Personal Individual Career Advancement Then It's Hard for People To Believe What To Trust that Their Representatives Are Actually Looking Out for Them So What's the Consequence of this the Consequence of this Is this Very Low Voter Turnout in the United States and Now Part of It Is Our Representational System Per Se

And He Said He Really Thought It Was Important for a Representative To Function like a Community Organizer To Function as Someone Who Would Mobilize His or Her Constituents To Hold Them Accountable So in Many Ways the Argument I'm Trying To Make Is that We Need To Look at the Experience of those Who Have Been Left Out those Who Are in a Minority Who Often Don't Get Their Preferences Represented Directly because They Are in a Minority and See this as a Function of a Winner-Take-all Electoral System That Puts Too Much Emphasis on Elections That Uses Geographic Districts as the Main Instrument for Allocating Political Power That Gives Representatives the Opportunity To Draw those Districts for Themselves
