Error in thinking about trauma, of focusing on event and not on bodily reaction and feelings

Stephen's new book 'Polyvagal safety: attachment, communication, self-regulation'

Physical and mental illness are the same, but medical professionals aren't taught this

Vagal metrics to help explain 'medically unexplained symptoms'

Social connection and safety directly assist neural regulation

'Neural exercise' (play and social interaction) should be a fundamental part of a healthy education

Authoritarian threat based education methods inhibit rather than motivate learning

Moving beyond Paul McLean's outdated concepts of the Triune brain and the Limbic system

Polyvagal theory working bottom up has simplicity but working top down has complexity

Being listened to is crucial to feeling safe

Voice cues for safety have been critical to man's survival
