Manner of Articulation Stops: Airflow in the oral cavity is stopped

Affricates : Stop immediately followed by a fricative

Nasals: Velum lowered and air goes through

Liquids: Continuous airflow without turbulence.

Flap Briefly strike two articulators together.

Glottal State Voiceless: vocal folds separated. Voiced: vocal folds tightly closed
