Florida is ceded to the USA. The U.S. agreed to pay the legal claims of American citizens against Spain, to a maximum of \$5 million.

The boundary between the Louisiana Territory and Spanish Mexico is changed.

Finally, Spain abandons all claims over the Oregon Territory.

From outposts in the Caribbean, waves of explorers and conquistadores fanned out across the region.

Conquistadores Soldiers who fought in the name of God and the Spanish Crown

The Spanish Crown dispatched viceroys, or governors, who were responsible for enforcing law, expanding the territory, and overseeing mining and ranching operations.

Catholic priests came to convert indigenous peoples to Christianity.

Encomienda Grant by the Spanish Crown giving a colonizer the right to demand forced labor and tribute, usually gold or land, from indigenous peoples

Although technically not slavery, many considered the practice cruel.

Encomienda fell out of practice only after disease and mistreatment led to the deaths of large portions of the indigenous population.

European men controlled the local indigenous populations through encomienda.

Many conquistadores married indigenous women from ruling families to take control of the preexisting social hierarchy.
