TAXONOMY- PRINCIPLES AND PROCEDURES

Basis for classification: Classification is the ordering of a large group of organisms based on certain characters into small

Certain taxonomic categories are obligate, while others are optional. For Ex. Systematic position of Indian honey-bee

Nomenclature and identification

I. Common name They are inaccurate because it varies from region to region and country to country and there is no uniformity followed in naming the organisms

(II) Same common name is used for insects of different orders

IL Scientific name: • The system of naming organisms using two words is called Binomial nomenclature (Trinomial nomenclature if three words are used)

The first letter of the generic name is in capital and the first letter of species and subspecies are in small letter
