The Arts and Crafts of Literacy

During the last two decades, the (re-)discovery of thousands of manuscripts in different regions of sub-Saharan Africa has questioned the long-standing approach of Africa as a continent only characterized by orality and legitimately assigned to the continent the status of a civilization of written literacy. However, most of the existing studies mainly aim at serving literary and historical purposes, and focus only on the textual dimension of the manuscripts. Quitting smoking is very difficult. 90-95% of smokers who try to quit smoking on their own resume smoking within a year.

Nobody uses an entire pod or tank of high-nicotine liquid in one use, so it would stand to reason that it would contain enough to replace a pack of cigarettes. Replacing cigarettes is a good thing. Flavors are attractive to everyone, including adults looking to quit smoking. A study funded by the FDA & NIH confirmed this

CTFK & fellow Bloomberg-funded groups do lobby & fund government programs worldwide. This is not a good thing.

It does appear that groups like Tobacco-Free Kids helped put the "teen in Nicotine". While it is true that some launch ads from one well-known nicotine vapor brand targeted young people years earlier, it wasn't until health groups launched the "epidemic" narrative that rates of use went up.

Sadly, the death & disease from smoking worldwide is concentrated in low- and middle-income communities/countries. This includes the Black community, indigenous populations, and the GLBTQ+ community...the very people they hired to misinform these groups.
