To look upon his children as my own brothers

and to teach them this art - if they desire to learn it- without fee and covenant
to give a share of precepts and oral instruction and all the other learning

to my own sons, and to those of him who has been my teacher

and to disciples who have signed the covenant and have taken an oath according to the medical law
I will apply dietetic measures for the benefit of the sick according to my ability and judgment

I will keep them from harm and injustice.

I will give no deadly medicine to any one if asked

nor suggest any such counsel

Similarly I will not give to a woman an abortive remedy
In purity and holiness I will preserve my life and my art.
I will not use the knife, even on sufferers from stone.
but will let this operation to specialized practitioners.

Whatever houses I may visit, I will come for the benefit of the sick
keeping myself far from all intentional injustice and ill-doing, among others
of sexual deeds on bodies female or male, be they free or slaves.

What I may see or hear in the course of the treatment or even outside of it in regard to the life of men
which ought not to be spread outside, I will keep secret considering them improper to talk about
If I keep this oath and not violate it

may I enjoy my life and my art respected by all men and in all time to come.

But if I transgress it and swear falsely, let the reverse be my lot
