between 1943 and June of 1948. IBIS THE INVINCIBLE VOLUME ONE collects all six of those issues advertisement free. Ibis was originally Prince Amentep in ancient Egypt. Ibis was given the incredibly powerful magic stick to wield wisely during his rule. Circumstances forced Ibis and the Ibistick, along with his partner Princess Taia to spend 4,000 years in suspended animation. Upon awaking in two separate museums, Ibis and Taia (of course) decide to dedicate their lives to fighting crime and save lives. Ibis was created by Bob Kingett.
