remove each one of your lug nuts

turn the wheels in the direction of whatever side we're working

move the brake caliper out of the way

remove the brake pads

take both slider pins out clean

pull the little slider pin out

removing the brake pad

remove the brake caliper

remove these bolts both on the bottom and top

replace the brake rotor

ground itself down all the way through the lining of the brake

cleaning up the slider pins removing all the silicon paste

putting a different kind of silicon paste inside the slider pin

cleaned out the inside part of the brake carrier

put both slider pins into the bracket

get the brake pad to slide

prevent the brake rotor from seizing to the hub

replace them when reinstalling the caliper

align the slider pins on to the holes

repeat this exact same procedure to all three other corners of the car

replace the pads

measure the thickness of the brake rotor by just measuring it up

take a look at the outside part of the pad

relocate the pads the piston the slider pins

throw back on the car torque up the lug nuts
