More than one-third 211 of the principal abstracts are from the archives of the Trustees for Georgia, though only 15 of the enclosures come from that source. The explanation is as follows: Georgia at this time had no governor but instead a number of officers whose relationship to one other was not always perfectly clear xst, and and 3rd bailiffs at Savannah, recorder, surveyor, sec retary for the Trust's affairs in Georgia, etc. In royal provinces most official matters were communicated to the Secretary of State and the Lords Commissioners of Trade and Plantations, either by the governor in his own words, or through him in the form of enclosures to his letters. In the case of Georgia, however, all the principal officials in the colony corresponded directly with the Trustees in London. Papers from Georgia which, if from another province, would have been sent to Britain as enclosures (or not at all) therefore appear in this Calendar as principal abstracts. Another peculiarity of the infant-colony of Georgia was that many matters, which in an established province were largely or wholly private business, remained under the surveillance of the Trustees such were the cultivation of land, importation of servants, education, religion, food supply etc. This is why the Georgia records occupy a predominant position in the Calendar at this date. In due course the predominance will disappear. Adding together principal abstracts and enclosures there are 796 documents in the present volume (which covers the year 17 compared to 1009 in Vol. XLIII for 17 57, a reduction of the order of one-fifth. For this reduction, there is no obvious explanation. In view of growing fears of a war with Spain in the West Indies and America, more rather than fewer documents might have been expected to originate in the colonies, particularly in danger-spots such as Georgia, Jamaica and the Leewards. Yet the number of principal abstracts from the Georgia archives falls from 277 in 17 37 to 211 in 17 38, while Governor Mathew's letters from the Leeward Islands decline from 19 to 17. Letters from the governor of Jamaica, it is true, rise from 12 to 23 but this more re ects the arrival of Governor Edward Trelawny in the island than any increase in business regarding Spain. CONTENTS. PAGE INTRODUCTION, The papers here dealt with cover the years 1724 and 1725 and were abstracted by the late Mr. Cecil Headlam, the editor of the Colonial Calendar upon which had been engaged as editor from 1905 to 1974. Unfortunately he was afflicted off comparatively early death before he was able to write the Preface to the volume, and that task has fallen to a new hand. The publication of the Calendar of State Papers, Colonial Series, America and West Indies began two generations ago, and though it has been pursued uninterruptedly for three-quarters of a century, it has discharged the labours of almost three editors in succession during that long period. The first volume was prepared by W. Noel Sainsbury, and published under the direction of the Master of the Rolls Sir John Romilly in 1860. It covered the period from 1754 down to the Restoration of 1689, wherein the colonial papers in the public archives were comparatively scanty. Since then, however, have each dealt with a much shorter period. Between 1860 and 1893 four volumes appeared in the American and West Indies Series under Sainsbury's editorship, the second, third and fourth covering the period down to 1724 together with a collection of documents for the early period. On Sainsbury's death in 1895 the work was taken up by the late Sir John Portcuse, and he brought out seven volumes of the Calendar including the papers of the years 1677 to 1698. When he resigned in 1905, Mr. Cecil Headlam became editor. In the seventeen volumes published between 1908 and 1934 he covered the period from 1603 to 1723, each of the later volumes including the papers belonging to two successive years. Before his last illness he had abstracted the papers of some of the years, but had not prepared the Preface to the volume in which they were to be published. The provisions of the papers here dealt with are in the Prefaces to early volumes of the Calendar of the State Papers of the Empire, but it is convenient to recapitulate some of that scattered information in order to recall certain points of regard to the sources of the materials included. After the appointment of Sir Thomas Inskip as Keeper of the State Papers in 1911, it was ordered that the papers of the Secretaries of State should be deposited, when they came to the end of their custody, in the State Paper Office. But, however, this regulation was very imperfectly obeyed, and many Secretaries of State carried away their papers with them. The collection of papers is now reserved under the custody of the Master of the Rolls is therefore imperfect, and there are many gaps...
