Please PAUSE the video after each step to draw at your own pace.

Draw a circle near the right side of the paper as a guide for the front part of the king cheetah's body. To the left, draw another circle the same way as a guide for the back part of the body.

On the right side of the first circle, drew yet another circle as a guide for the head.

Draw a horizontal line across the head to help you place the facial features later.

Draw a small circle on the lower right side of the head as a guide for the muzzle.

On top of the head, near the sides, draw two short ares as guides for the ears.

Connect the top of the head to the top of the first circle as the guide for the first part of the neck.

Make the arc of this line tall. Draw a line connecting the shapes at the bottom to complete the neck.

Draw a long line under the first circle as a guide for the front leg.

Bend the line at the top to indicate where the joint will be and at the bottom for the foot.

Draw a long, angled line under the second circle as a guide for the hind leg.

This line should slope to the lower, left side before bending at the bottom to indicate where the joints and foot will be

Lightly sketch the eyes inside the head as two small ovals.

Use the initial lines as guides for the placement and size of the eyes.

Darken the sides of the oval but curve the line inward to create the nostrils.

Make the top comers of the nose pointy. Make the bottom part of the nose thin.

Under the nose, draw a line that curves to the left for the first half of the mouth.

Draw a couple of curved lines that connect the inner corners of the eyes to the sides of the mouth for the tear markings.

At the bottom, use the edges of the initial circle as guides for the placement of

Use the ares on top of the head as guides to draw the cars.

Inside each ear draw a series of short strokes for fur.

Use the bigger circle as a guide draw the rest of the head

Draw a series of short strokes along the edge of the circle to create the furry shape of the head.

Use the second line from the right as a guide to draw the first trent leg.

Follow the path of the guide and lightly sketch the shape of the leg around it.

When you get the shape of the leg right, darken the lines. Use short strokes at the top for fur.

Draw the the shape of the leg close to the guide to keep the leg skinny

Use the line on the right as a guide to draw the other front leg the same way

Darken the lines when you get the shape right. Where the shape bends at the bottom, draw a U-shaped line for the first loe.

Keep the edges of the pary close to the guide so that the shape is skinny

Use the angled line on the far left as a guide to draw the first hind leg.

Notice how much thicker the top of this leg is compared to the front leg.

The shape should gradually get narrower toward the bottom.

Use the last angled line as a guide to draw the other hind leg the same way.

Draw the leg around the guide. Bend the shape in the middle for the joint and add the toes as curved lines at the bottom.

Add tiny triangular shapes on the tips of the toes for the claws. The top part of this leg will be hidden behind the body.

Use the remaining lines and shapes as guides to draw the rest of the body.

Use short strokes along the curved guide at the top for the fur standing up on the back.

Darken the outer edges of the initial guides to create the rest of the body

Don't overlap the limbs that are on this side of the body. Add some strokes on the neck for extra detail.

Use short strokes for the tip of the tail and add a curved line at the bottom to complete the shape.

Go over the final sketch lines with a pen, marker or any other type of permanent ink.

Something's missing. The coat pattern. Add the king cheetah's distinctive coat pattern all over the body using ink.

Follow the curvature of the body shape as you add the striped pattern on the back.

The markings at the top should be long, and they should gradually get shorter the farther down they are.

If you want a regular **cheetah**, using this pose, just draw ...

Color your king **cheetah drawing**,! Use light yellow for ...

Use light brown and a bit of gray to add shadows throughout the body.

Pick the direction of the light source so that the shadows are consistent with it

Add yellow directly on top of the brown and gray in the areas between the coat pattern.

Add the colors lightly at first and slowly build up to the shade of yellow that you like. Keep the area around the eyes and muzzle blank.

Use more light brown to emphasize the shadows and black to emphasize the coat pattern. Color the eyes red.

Draw a cast shadow under the body using light brown, gray and a bit of purple.

Draw two circles as a guide for the first part of the cheetah's body.

If you do want a perfect circle, trace the outer rim of a coin, bottle cap, or anything else circular.

Cheetahs stretch out when they run, so place the second circle far away from the first one to make the body long.

The second circle should also be smaller than the first. Leave enough room on the sides and bottom for the head and feet.

Draw another circle on the left side as a guide for the head.

This circle should be smaller. Draw it about one-third the size of the first circle.

Don't place it too far away from the first circle, otherwise the cheetah's neck will be too long.

Draw an angled line on the left side of the head as a guide for the muzzle.

The left side of the shape of the muzzle shouldn't stick out too much. It should be pretty flat.

Draw a small arc on top of the head as a guide for the ear. Add a curved line to the left of the arc for the ear on the other side.

Draw two angled lines (one under each circle) as guides for the legs that are on this side of the body. The line on the left side should be similar to the letter Z on its side.

The line on the right side should angle once as it comes out of the circle, then stretch back pretty straight.

Cheetahs have long limbs, so draw these guides long too.

Now draw two more angled lines under each circle as guides for the legs that are on the other side of the body.

It's okay if the lines overlap a little. Pay attention to how the lines bend. This will indicate where the joints will be later.

Draw a series of curved lines that connect the major shapes to form the rest of the body.

Draw two lines on the left side that connect the head and body to form the neck.

Add two lines in the middle to form the torso. The line at the bottom should curve more to indicate the chest.

Add a long wavy line on the right side as a guide for the tail.

Draw a small half-circle inside the head, on the upper left side, for the eye.

Sketch lightly at first to get the shape and placement right.

Darken the edges of the eye using a thicker line when you get the shape and placement right Add an extra line on the top, left side of the eye for the fur and add a tiny dot inside the eye for the pupil.

Draw an extra thick line on the outer, lower, left section for the corner of the eye.

Shade the inside of the eye a little near the top

As you shade, use a value that's lighter than the pupil and outer edges of the eye.

Lightly sketch a triangle inside the shape of the muzzle at the top for the nose.

Use a wavy line for the top of the nose as you darken the shape.

Darken the sides of the nose too but make the lines a bit curvier.

Draw a small slit- like line inside the shape of the nose for the nostrils.

Draw the rest of the muzzle using the initial angled line as a guide.

Draw an angled line that starts under the nose, then stretches to the right toward the head for the mouth.

Draw a smaller curved line to the left for the other side of the mouth.

Draw another curved line under the mouth for the bottom lip.

Follow the bottom edge of the guide to draw the chin. Use quick, short strokes to represent fur.

Darken the arcs on top of the head to create the shapes of the ears.

Add a line within the arc for the ear's edge and a few quick, short strokes for the furry texture.

Use the initial circle and lines as guides to draw the rest of the head.

Follow the basic path of the guides as you darken the lines to create the head.

Use guick, short strokes as you draw the shape of the head to indicate the fur.

The line for the bottom of the head should stretch toward the inside of the shapes to create the jawline.

Use the angled lines as guides to draw the legs that are on this side of the body.

Lightly sketch the shape of the leg as you follow the basic path of the guide line.

When you get the structure of the leg right, darken the lines.

The top part of the leg should be thicker than the bottom. The thinnest part should be the joint before the paw.

Draw the paw pointing down because it's hanging pretty loose as the front leg takes the stride.

Use a couple of small curved lines at the bottom of the paw to indicate the individual toes.

Draw the hind leg that's on this side of the body the same way.

First lightly sketch the shape of the leg as you follow the basic path of the guide. Follow the top line, not the bottom one.

As you sketch the shape of the leg, be sure to draw the top part a lot thicker than the bottom

Unlike the front leg, the hind leg should not be pointing down. It should be stretched back toward the right.

Add a couple of curved lines at the tip to indicate the toes pointing up.

Now draw the legs that are on the other side of the body by using the remaining lines as guides.

Follow the path of the guide as you create the shape of the leg. Don't overlap the lines of the leg in front of it.

Use curved lines on the tip of the paw for the toes. Add a small line at the end of the toes for the claws.

Draw the paw and toes big because the foot is spread out wide as it braces for impact.

Now follow the basic path of the line on the right to draw the hind leg on the other side of the body.

Most of this leg is hidden behind the other hind leg, so only draw the bottom half of it.

Use the remaining lines as guides to draw the rest of the body and tail.

Simply follow the basic outer path of the initial guides and darken the lines to create the shape of the body.

Use a few quick, short strokes on the underside of the body for the furry texture.

Now follow the path of the wavy line on the right to create the thick shape of the tail.

Cheetahs use their long, muscular tales as rudders to steer their bodies to turn sharply as they run and chase prey.

optional): For a cleaner look, erase as much as you can of the initial guide lines

Don't worry about erasing all of the guides. It's okay to leave some behind.

Re-draw any final sketch lines that you may have accidentally erased.

optional): Add some shading to your drawing to give it more dimension and volume.

Pick the direction of the light source when shading so that the shadows are consistent with it.

Vary the pressure on your pencil to get different degrees of tonal value.

... emphasize that the **cheetah**, is off the ground as it runs.

It can't be a **cheetah**, without spots! Start by adding the ...

Use a dark value for the back portion of the ears and on the nose.

Add the tear-like streaks that start on the left side of the eye and end on the right side of the mouth.

Make the streak thicker at the bottom and add a dark value to the bottom lip too.

Draw a shorter, thinner streak on the right side of the eye too.

Start adding small spots on the head Avoid drawing any directly in front of the face, especially above the nose.

Make the spots bigger the farther back toward the body they are.

There's no trick or shortcut for adding the coat pattern. You just have to add A LOT of spots all over the body.

Make the spots different sizes. Draw a few big ones spread out, then add a lot of little ones in the spaces between

Adding each spot is very time- consuming, so be patient and take breaks. Some of this process will be edited out, otherwise the video would be too long

Draw the spots smaller the closer they are to the paw.

Consider drawing the spots on a certain section, say the legs, then taking a break and doing another section later. That way it's not too overwhelming.

Make the spots bigger the closer they get to the end of the tail until they become bands instead of spots near the tip.

Add a few more smaller spots in any gaps you see between the bigger spots.

optional): You can add even more value throughout your drawing for extra detail.

As you shade the body, use a value that's a lot lighter than the spots.

As you add this value to the body, you can also darken the shadows created in step 17.

As you shade, use strokes that go in the general direction of the fur.

Cheetahs' fur isn't too long, so use shorter, smooth strokes to convey this.
