What we learned • Assessment must consider who person is, their understanding of the illness and how they are interpreting and reacting to the illness • Multiple assessments over time are helpful in determining consistency of wishes

Minimum 90-day assessment period • One of two assessments to be completed by a practitioner with expertise in the condition that is causing the person's suffering • Mandatory offering of appropriate counseling services e.g. mental health, disability support, palliative care
