On the Contrary

Solution: 2 meanings of self-evident

Self evident in itself = predicate included in essence of subject

The proposition is self evident to whoever knows the essence of the subject

Is "Chiliagons have 1000 sides" self evident to you?

Apply this insight to our knowledge of God

"God exists" is self evident in itself, predicate included in essence of subject

We do not know the essence of God, so "God exists" is not self-evident to us, but must be demonstrated by God's effects
