A ribbon and lace choker was popular in the 1760s.

Next is the underpetticoat

The underpetticoat provides an additional layer of warmth and padding under the stays.

Now for the stays

The boned stomacher helps with pinning the gown later on.

Panniers, also called pocket hoops, hold the skirt out in the fashionable silhouette

Panniers came in a variety of shapes and sizes.

They also served as very capacious pockets!

Next is the petticoat.

The petticoat is split at the sides, allowing access to the pocket hoops.

The petticoat ties on back-to-front, then front-to-back

This type of gown is called a "sacque" or a "robe a la Francaise."

It was popular in various incarnations for almost the entire 18th century

Jewelry is the final addition
