Although largely unknown today, during his lifetime Mutio Oddi of Urbino (1569–1639) was a highly esteemed scholar, teacher, and practitioner of a wide range of disciplines related to mathematics. A prime example of the artisan-scholar so prevalent in the late Renaissance, Oddi was also accomplished in the fields of civil and military architecture and the design and retail of mathematical instruments, as well as writing and publishing. In Between Raphael and Galileo, Alexander Marr resurrects the career and achievements of Oddi in order to examine the ways in which mathematics, material culture, and the book shaped knowledge, society, and the visual arts in late Renaissance Italy. Marr scrutinizes the extensive archive of Oddi papers, documenting Oddi's collaboration with prominent intellectuals and officials and shedding new light on the practice of science and art during his day. What becomes clear is that Oddi, precisely because he was not spectacularly innovative and did not attain the status of a hero in modern science, is characteristic of the majority of scientific practitioners and educators active in this formative age, particularly those whose energetic popularization of mathematics laid the

Costruire 'alla moderna'. Materiali e tecniche a Genova tra XV e XVI secolo

Firenze capitale del Regno d'Italia (1864-1870) conosce una stagione di grandi trasformazioni, che lasceranno tracce significative nell'immagine e nella struttura urbana. La costruzione dei nuovi mercati è emblematica della modernizzazione infrastrutturale della città, con l'innesto di nuovi linguaggi architettonici e tecnologie costruttive di respiro internazionale. Il Mercato Centrale di San Lorenzo è uno degli edifici più rappresentativi di questo processo di modernizzazione, capolavoro di Giuseppe Mengoni, celebre progettista della Galleria Vittorio Emanuele II di Milano. A fior d'arte

Nata alcuni decenni or sono dall'esigenza di salvare manufatti non artistici o monumentali, ma significativi a livello storico ed urbanistico, resi ormai funzionalmente obsoleti dallo sviluppo industriale postbellico, l'archeologia industriale ha svolto una funzione essenziale per l'individuazione e parziale preservazione di un patrimonio culturale che all'epoca non rientrava nella tutela dei beni artistici e monumentali. Essa però, per merito di Eugenio Battisti, che fu tra i primissimi ad occuparsi di archeologia industriale in Italia e per decenni ne ha promosso le attività a livello nazionale e internazionale, ha dato luogo anche ad una riflessione a ben più ampio raggio sui problemi più profondi della società moderna. Il presente volume mette in luce il percorso che l'autore ha compiuto in due direzioni: da una parte cercando i segni e le testimonianze della protostoria industriale nei secoli precedenti; dall'altra indagando le nuove prospettive che l'archeologia industriale apriva sulla storia del lavoro e della sua organizzazione, delle invenzioni tecniche e delle loro applicazioni alla produzione, del rapporto tra economia, lavoro, sviluppo urbano e le loro periodiche crisi. Ne emerge un quadro impressionante di continuità e ciclicità, a partire dalla ripresa economica e mercantile dell'alto Medioevo fino alle

devastanti crisi degli ultimi nostri decenni, quando le nuove tecnologie e la globalizzazione del mercato hanno reso insostenibile il lavoro centralizzato ed organizzato in enormi fabbriche, hanno imposto nuove professionalità, hanno comportato il disfacimento del tessuto industriale tradizionale fondato sui grandi complessi. Battisti sostiene che la vera rivoluzione non è moderna, bensì è iniziata nel Medioevo e che, cifre alla mano, le crisi della nostra epoca non sono il fenomeno eccezionale di uno sviluppo unico nella storia, ma ripetono una fenomenologia che, sia pure in contesti e condizioni diverse, è riscontrabile in altre fasi espansive e recessive, per esempio nel Trecento o nel Cinquecento. Tale conclusione, ben lungi dal costituire un'apologia del passato, vuol evocare quanto sia complesso il fenomeno industriale, al punto da coinvolgere, oltre ai già citati aspetti dell'economia e del lavoro, l'intero modo di vivere entro la società, entro l'ambiente urbano, entro il territorio. Dalla ricchezza problematica di questo volume risulta più che mai ribadita la necessità che i manufatti connessi all'archeologia industriale, in quanto testimonianze materiali di molti altri aspetti della storia umana, siano preservati, possibilmente nella consistenza e con le attrezzature esistenti al momento della loro dismissione. Però non debbono restare scheletri passivi, ha sostenuto più volte Battisti, ma debbono essere inseriti di nuovo nelle attività attuali, mediante un riuso moderno, rispettoso e qualificante, come si era incominciato a fare già alla fine degli anni Ottanta nelle principali città statunitensi.

Tra il 1912 e il 1917 Monneret riportò con ostinazione di appassionato indagatore di antichità, ma anche di consapevole cittadino, attento alle modifiche in atto o prevedibili, l'attenzione di colleghi e intellettuali sui destini di guesta fabbrica, coinvolta pesantemente dal Piano Urbanistico Generale di Pavia-Masera, che avrebbe visto solo fra il 1939 e soprattutto dopo i danni bellici del 1943 sia l'attento restauro di Gino Chierici, che l'accrescersi drammatico dei problemi dell'intorno della Basilica, certo non terminati ad oggi, quando Monneret ormai lontano a Roma era per i più un riconosciuto studioso di arte copta e islamica in Italia e nel mondo. Convegno e studi si sono lentamente costruiti nell'uno e nell'altro settore, senza potersi dire oggi conclusi, ma acquisendo un patrimonio di indagini, che, come spesso accade, sono motori di ulteriori ricerche. Per Monneret si sono aperti insieme interrogativi e risposte sulla cultura architettonica della Milano dei primi trent'anni del Novecento e dei suoi rapporti con la filosofia, la critica artistica e la storiografia non solo italiana, si è riproposto all'attenzione il suo non compiuto catalogo delle opere di arte islamica in Italia, che meriterebbe di trovare una conclusione. Per San Lorenzo si stanno ora, dopo il convegno, identificando le stagioni della fabbrica medievale e rinascimentale, che offrono l'occasione unica di ricomprendere la cultura dell'antico a Milano nelle lunghe vicende della fabbrica e nelle sue ricostruzioni, non soltanto da un punto di vista antiquario, ma proprio come cultura operativa della costruzione e volontà di conservare memoria, anche attraverso altri monumenti milanesi. L'alto livello di conoscenza dei manufatti va oggi fatto, particolarmente nel caso di uno dei più straordinari edifici della cultura occidentale, quale San Lorenzo, con le più alte competenze tecnologiche; queste, integrandosi sia fra di loro che con l'interpretazione del dato storiografico ci portano a collocare la fabbrica e il suo volto, le sue complesse stratificazioni nella più attendibile cronologia, a costruire il presupposto interpretativo della durabilità dei materiali e delle tecniche, propedeusi insostituibile del suo mantenimento o restauro.
