This book explores that transformation, a conscious construction and reshaping of identity from within. *Cacicas* feature far and wide in the history of Spanish America, as female governors and tribute collectors and as relatives of ruling *caciques*—or their destitute widows. They played a crucial role in the establishment and success of Spanish rule, but were also instrumental in colonial natives' resistance and self-definition. In this volume, noted scholars uncover the history of colonial *cacicas*, moving beyond anecdotes of individuals in Spanish America. Their work focuses on the evolution of indigenous leadership, particularly the lineage and succession of these positions in different regions, through the lens of native women's political activism. Such activism might mean the intervention of *cacicas* in the economic, familial, and religious realms or their participation in official and unofficial matters of governance. The authors explore the role of such personal authority and political influence across a broad geographic, chronological, and thematic range—in patterns of succession, the settling of frontier regions, interethnic relations and the importance of purity of blood, gender and family dynamics, legal and marital strategies for defending communities, and the continuation of indigenous governance. This volume showcases colonial *cacicas* as historical subjects who constructed their consciousness around their place, whether symbolic or geographic, and articulated their own unique identities. It expands our understanding of the significant influence these women exerted—within but also well beyond the native communities of Spanish America.

The Criminals of Lima and Their Worlds

The Criminals of Lima and Their Worlds is the first major historical study of the creation and development of the prison system in Peru. Carlos Aguirre examines the evolution of prisons for male criminals in Lima from the conception—in the early 1850s—of the initial plans to build penitentiaries through the early-twentieth-century prison reforms undertaken as part of President Augusto Leguia's attempts to modernize and expand the Peruvian state. Aguirre reconstructs the social, cultural, and doctrinal influences that determined how lawbreakers were treated, how programs of prison reform fared, and how inmates experienced incarceration. He argues that the Peruvian prisons were primarily used not to combat crime or to rehabilitate allegedly deviant individuals, but rather to help reproduce

and maintain an essentially unjust social order. In this sense, he finds that the prison system embodied the contradictory and exclusionary nature of modernization in Peru. Drawing on a large collection of prison and administrative records archived at Peru's Ministry of Justice, Aguirre offers a detailed account of the daily lives of men incarcerated in Lima's jails. In showing the extent to which the prisoners actively sought to influence prison life, he reveals the dynamic between prisoners and guards as a process of negotiation, accommodation, and resistance. He describes how police and the Peruvian state defined criminality and how their efforts to base a prison system on the latest scientific theories—imported from Europe and the United States—foundered on the shoals of financial constraints, administrative incompetence, corruption, and widespread public indifference. Locating his findings within the political and social mores of Lima society, Aguirre reflects on the connections between punishment, modernization, and authoritarian traditions in Peru.

Smoldering Ashes

In *Smoldering Ashes* Charles F. Walker interprets the end of Spanish domination in Peru and that country's shaky transition to an autonomous republican state. Placing the indigenous population at the center of his analysis, Walker shows how the Indian peasants played a crucial and previously unacknowledged role in the battle against colonialism and in the political clashes of the early republican period. With its focus on Cuzco, the former capital of the Inca Empire, *Smoldering Ashes* highlights the promises and frustrations of a critical period whose long shadow remains cast on modern Peru. Peru's Indian majority and non-Indian elite were both opposed to Spanish rule, and both groups participated in uprisings during the late colonial period. But, at the same time, seething tensions between the two groups were evident, and non-Indians feared a mass uprising. As Walker shows, this internal conflict shaped the many struggles to come, including the Tupac Amaru uprising and other Indian-based rebellions, the long War of Independence, the caudillo civil wars, and the Peru-Bolivian Confederation. *Smoldering Ashes* not only reinterprets these conflicts but also examines the debates that took place—in the courts, in the press, in taverns, and even during public festivities—over the place of Indians in the republic. In clear and elegant prose, Walker explores why the fate of the indigenous population, despite its participation in decades of anticolonial battles, was little improved by republican rule, as Indians were denied citizenship in the new nation—an unhappy legacy with which Peru still grapples. Informed by the notion of political culture and grounded in Walker's archival research and knowledge of Peruvian and Latin American history, *Smoldering Ashes* will be essential reading for experts in Andean history, as well as scholars and students in the fields of nationalism, peasant and Native American studies, colonialism and postcolonialism, and state formation.

Gender and the Boundaries of Dress in Contemporary Peru

Set in Arequipa during Peru's recent years of crisis, this ethnography reveals how dress creates gendered bodies. It explores why people wear clothes, why people make art, and why those things matter in a war-torn land. Blenda Femenías argues that women's clothes are key symbols of gender identity and resistance to racism. Moving between metropolitan Arequipa and rural Caylloma Province, the central characters are the Quechua- and Spanish-speaking maize farmers and alpaca herders of the Colca Valley. Near-surface Geophysics

The development of the base-load capable, climate-friendly, and practically inexhaustible source of "geothermal energy" represents an important pillar of the energy supply of the future. If it were possible to expand geothermal energy production accordingly, Germany could generate 100% of its energy in a climate-neutral manner by 2050. The joint research project "Dolomitkluft," funded by the German Federal Ministry for Economic Affairs and Energy from 2016 to 2018, aims to establish a new and improved reservoir model for the Upper Jurassic carbonates of the Northern Alpine Foreland Basin for

deep geothermal energy. Emerged from this project, the dissertation by Mr. Stockinger geomechanically and numerically characterizes the deep geothermal reservoir in carbonate rocks—limestones and dolomites—of the Upper Jurassic in the Northern Alpine Foreland Basin in over 4000 m depth. This book specifically addresses fracture initiation, propagation, and hydraulic conductivity around a borehole and their controlling factors such as the in situ stress, the existing discontinuity network, and the geomechanical rock properties. Mr. Stockinger has thus successfully addressed the most important aspects for the retrievability of deep geothermal energy at its point of origin—namely the (deep) borehole.

Fracturing in Deep Boreholes

This is an up-to-date review of developments in the field of bifurcations and instabilities in geomechanics from some of the world's leading experts. Leading international researchers and practitioners of the topics debate the developments and applications which have occurred over the last few decades. Beside fundamental research findings, applications in geotechnical, petroleum, mining, and bulk materials engineering are emphasised.

Bifurcations, Instabilities, Degradation in Geomechanics

This book is the international edition of the proceedings of IS-Seoul 2011, the Fifth International Symposium on Deformation Characteristics of Geomaterials, held in Seoul, South Korea, in September 2011. The book includes 7 invited lectures, as well as 158 technical papers selected from the 182 submitted. Inhaltsangabe:Zusammenfassung: In den letzten Jahren wurde durch mehrere Arbeiten gezeigt, daß der Bonner Raum in weit größerem Maße als bisher angenommen von Hangrutschungen überformt wurde. Durch geomorphologische Detailkartierungen in unbebauten Gebieten - und hier besonders unter Wald - konnten bisher unbekannte Rutschungen neu bestimmt und beschrieben werden. Hierbei handelt es sich zu einem großen Teil um quasinatürliche Hangrutschungen rezenten bis prähistorischen Alters. Als besonders wichtige Rutschhorizonte sind hier der württembergische Knollenmergel des Mittleren Keupers sowie der Opalinuston und der Ornatenton des jurassischen Doggers zu nennen. Ein weiterer Untersuchungsschwerpunkt liegt im Bereich der tertiären Ablagerungen rund um das Mainzer Becken. Als rutschungsfördernd sind dort verschiedene tertiäre Tonschichten sowie quellfähige, tonige Mergel (z.B. der Cyrenenmergel) beschrieben. Inhaltsangabe:Zusammenfassung:Ziel der vorliegenden Diplomarbeit ist der Aufbau einer kleinkalibrigen Bohrlochsonde zur in-situ Bestimmung der elastischen Eigenschaften von Ablagerungen im ungesättigten Teil des Lockergesteinsbereichs. Die konventionelle Seismik arbeitet mit Frequenzen zwischen 1 bis max. 103 Hz. Der Einsatz von Ultraschall zur Bestimmung der Schallgeschwindigkeit von Gesteinen bietet durch die Verwendung von höheren Frequenzen und damit geringen Wellenlängen die Möglichkeit, kleindimensionierte Geschwindigkeitsänderungen zu erfassen. Für Labormessungen eignen sich kleine Probenkörper, weshalb die Ultraschallmessung an Gesteinsproben zur Bestimmung ihrer elastischen Eigenschaften, ein seit langem eingesetztes Verfahren ist. Im Lockergesteinsbereich liegen die Wellenlängen bei der verwendeten Frequenz von $\nu = \pm 30$ kHz im Bereich einiger Zentimeter bis Dezimeter, was bei der Verwendung im Bohrloch eine sehr hohe vertikale Auflösung zuläßt. The occurrence and spatial distribution of cover beds are decisive for modern hillslope morphodynamics. This aspect is strongly associated with the geotechnical properties of cover beds and especially with their anisotropy. The impact of periglacial cover beds on mass movements, in particular landslides in subdued mountains, will be discussed in this section. The case studies in this chapter show that soil-physical and soil-mechanical properties significantly influence the forces in periglacial cover beds and, thus, directly control the slope stability. In contrast to long-lasting stable geomorphological factors, the reduction of shear strength, friction angle, and cohesion as well as the deformability may induce abrupt instability. Abrupt instabilities in periglacial cover beds particularly arise, when the soil-water content increases and, consequently, both the pore water and the hydrostatic pressures rise. In particular, we show that landslides to a large extent occur in hillslope sediments which are weakly consolidated and sensitive to water penetration.
