DEONTOLOGICAL ETHICS is closely associated with Immanuel Kant's model of ethical theory. It argues that the morality, that is, the rightness or wrongness, of a human act depends on whether such act fulfills a duty or not, rather than on its consequence.

Hence, deontological ethics is duty-based. As a matter of fact, deontology comes from the Greek word deon, which means duty.

One of the basic ideas in deontological ethics is that some actions are right or wrong in themselves, regardless of their consequences.

In deontological ethics, therefore, before we make moral decisions, we have to consider first which actions are right and wrong and proceed from there.

If an action is wrong in itself, then we are under a moral obligation to act accordingly.

Utilitarianism, rooted in empiricism, originated in the 18th century with Jeremy Bentham.

Empiricism posits that all knowledge begins with sensory experience.

Utilitarianism asserts that humans primarily pursue pleasure, grounded in anthropological realism.

Bentham contends that the ultimate goal of human existence is the pursuit of happiness.

Utilitarianism rejects distinctions between higher and lower pleasures; pleasure is pleasure.

Bentham rejects traditional morality, viewing it as abstract and deceptive.

Utilitarianism promotes the greatest happiness for the greatest number.

Utilitarianism involves a moral arithmetic, maximizing pleasure and minimizing suffering.

Hedonistic calculus, based on rationality, helps individuals weigh pleasure against suffering.
