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Poverty Alleviation through Tourism Development

The book offers a comprehensive and integrated approach to the topic of tourism development and its contribution to the fight against poverty. Tourism development is credited to be a powerful source of regional development and improvement in developing countries, and the focus of the book is on the world's poorest areas and how tourism connects to the poor and unlocks opportunities to escape the poverty trap. This book takes a comprehensive and unique approach by combining a decade of research on the effects of tourism development on poverty reduction in Latin America. The book explores poverty and its impact on development at the macro and micro levels. Then, it goes on to focus on tourism development and its effects on growth, inequality, and poverty reduction and how these dynamic relationships affect the most vulnerable groups of society. The research also documents on how the poor perceive tourism development on their lives and if they see it as an important vehicle to help them escape from poverty. Lastly, the authors map the conditions under which tourism can reach the poor and how tourism can offer opportunities for impoverished areas and their residents. Combining tourism dynamics, development economics, poverty reduction, business practices, and a sustainable perspective, the book takes a broad look at this important issue. Poverty Alleviation Through Tourism

This publication contains details of private or public tourism projects that have been presented by WTO Member States as examples of good, sustainable practices for poverty reduction through tourism. They are drawn from 26 case studies from 20 countries including three LDCs (least developed countries) of Ethiopia, Mali and Mozambique, and include examples of projects relating to agro-tourism, tourism micro-entrepreneur networks, village tourism, community-based hotels, parks or protected areas, guide training and handicraft development.

Tourism and Poverty Reduction

Over the past decade, there have been an increasing number of publications that have analysed and critiqued the potential of tourism to be a mechanism for poverty reduction in less economically developed countries (LEDCs). This book showcases work by established and emerging researchers that provides new thinking and tests previously made assumptions, providing an essential guide for students, practitioners and academics. This book advances our understanding of the changes and ways forward in the field of sustainable tourism development. Tourism, Poverty and Development

Poverty alleviation is high on the global policy agenda, its importance being emphasised by its place as the first of the United Nation's Millennium Development Goals. As a potentially significant source of economic growth in developing countries, tourism may also play a major role in poverty reduction and alleviation under the right circumstances. The Challenges of Tourism Development Towards Poverty Alleviation in Zanzibar. A Case Study of Kiwengwa Village

Research Paper from the year 2016 in the subject Tourism, course: TOURISM MANAGEMENT AND PLANNING, language: English, abstract: This study was carried out in Kiwengwa Zanzibar. The aim of this study was to assess the challenges of tourism development in poverty alleviation in Zanzibar. The case study of Kiwengwa village intends to assess the local community's opinion regarding tourism as a means of poverty alleviation as well as the level of the community participation in tourism development in Kiwengwa village. The primary data were collected using structured questionnaires and interviews. For quantitative data analysis was made using SPSS version 21. Qualitative data from the interview was coded and arranged according to their themes as they emerge which formed the basis for discussion. A sample size of 60 respondents was given questionnaires to fill and 5 were interviewed. Secondary data was collected from published and unpublished sources. The findings of the study reveal that there are negative attitudes towards tourism development in poverty reduction. The local residents in reality are not in agreement that tourism might promote community development and alleviate poverty in their respective areas. The result of this study also found that there are a number of barriers which hinders community participation in tourism development. Such barriers include: lack of financial resources, poor involvement in decision making, lack of empowerment of local communities in the management. Also the findings of the study reveal that Poor understanding and low level of awareness of tourism concept, foreign domination in the tourism industry, unequal distribution of financial resources and lack of involvement of financial institutions, limiting tourism development towards poverty reduction.

The Contribution of Tourism to Poverty Alleviation

Sustainable tourism can act as a catalyst for socio-economic development and poverty reduction, through job creation and productive employment, preservation of the natural environment and cultural traditions, and investment of tax revenues derived from tourism activities in education, health and infrastructure development. This publication contains papers presented at a seminar, held in Kathmandu in August 2003, which discuss experiences from selected Asian countries on the economic impact of tourism; and specific case studies of tourism development programmes, including from India, Indonesia, Nepal and Vietnam.

The Role of Tourism in Poverty Alleviation in Tanzania

Global trends have led to a marked decline in the role of the state in national development. Part of the Research on Poverty Alleviation series, aiming to deepen the understanding of the causes, extent, nature, rate of change and means of combating poverty in Tanzania. This paper argues that a higher economic growth rate that is pro-poor is a prerequisite for poverty alleviation. Rapid growth of the tourism sector is postulated as an important instrument of poverty alleviation, the creation of jobs, the sales of goods and services, support of the cultural industries and source of foreign exchange. The study however demonstrates the flip-side of tourism: that it is a complex industry often driven by the private sector to benefit international companies rather than local economies and causing environmental degradation. It concludes that more research is needed into the impact of tourism on

the livelihoods of the locals and to ensure that as Tanzania becomes a major tourist destination, the industry is harnessed to alleviate poverty and improve livelihoods.

Tourism, Microfinance and Poverty Alleviation
