Read One Account of the Resurrection We Read Matthew's Count Then List Everything That Happens Read Mark and List Everything Then Luke Lists Everything It's John Lists Everything List Everything That Happens and Compare Your Lists Do It Yourself Think for Yourself and Figure It Out Are They Accurate or Not Not if They Contradict each Other in Matthews Account When Jesus Is Raised from the Dead the Women Go to the Tomb and They'Re Told To Go Tell the Disciples that Jesus Will Meet Them in Galilee They Are To Tell the Disciples To Go to Galilee and Meet Jesus There the Women Go Tell the Disciples

I Then Offered Six Criteria by Which We May Assess Ancient Historical Literature and Contended the Gospels Meet all Six Therefore the Gospels Are Historically Reliable I'D Like Now To Review those Six Criteria in Light of Bart's Comments the First Criterion Is the Author Intended To Write an Accurate Account and Here I Contended that the Gospels Were Written So Close to the Events that Large-Scale Conjecturing by Their Authors Was Not Required Moreover the Gospel Authors Chose Not To Omit Embarrassing Details Which Suggests that They Intended To Write Accurate Accounts This Is the Kind of Way that History Was Reported It Is Not To Say that Matthew and John Were Inventing these Teachings of Jesus by no Means these Would Have Been Things that Jesus Would Have Taught but Not Necessarily all of Them on that Particular Occasion Number 5 We Can Verify Numerous Elements Reported by the Ancient Author Here I Contended that Many Items in the Gospels Can Be Verified Such as Names Places People and Many of Jesus Teachings and Deeds and this Went Uncontested Finally Number 6 no More than a Very Small Percentage of Items Reported by the Ancient Author Are False or Known To Be False

Finally Number 6 no More than a Very Small Percentage of Items Reported by the Ancient Author Are False or Known To Be False Here I Listed More than a Dozen Items That Are Reasonably Good Candidates for Being Errors Yet I Said that all of Them Are in Minor Details and Don't Undermine the Overall Reliability of the Accounts and I Don't Think that What Bart Said Challenged that all He Did Was Add some More to the List or Even Just Expounded on some of the Ones That I Gave for Example the Infancy Narratives He Says that the Sensitive Is Not Mentioned Anywhere Else

We Want To Know whether the Gospels Record What Jesus Said and Did Accurately Suppose You Find an Ancient Map and You Want To Know Is this Map Accurate Well You Wouldn't Ask Well You Know Did It Follow Ancient Methods of Following Maps so that Its Mistakes Can Be Explained and So Well by Ancient Standards It's Not Bad if You Ask Is this Map Accurate You'Re Asking if I Want To Go from Point a to Point B Will this Map Tell Me How To Do It or Not You Want To Know if It Is Accurate

You Want To Know if It Is Accurate Not whether the Person Was Limited in His Abilities To Write a Map but whether It's Accurate or Not We'Re Asking Are the Gospels Accurate or Not I Continue To Be a Little of a Surprise that Mike Doesn't Look at the Actual Evidence of the Gospels He Said that You Know Well I Didn't Refute His Six Six Points I'M One Reason I Didn't Refute His Six Points Is because I Didn't Know What His Six Points Were GonNa Be and
