The second planet Venus, is the hottest and brightest of all planets.

The third planet in the solar system is our planet Earth.

Nearly 70% of the Earth's surface is covered with water, due to which the Earth is also called the blue planet. It is the only planet on which life is known to exist.

The fourth planet is Mars. It is also known as the red planet, because of the presence of red soil and rocks.

The fifth and the largest planet in the solar system is Jupiter.

The sixth planet, i.e. Saturn is the second largest planet in the solar system.

The seventh planet is Uranus. A thick layer of gas covers this planet.

The eighth planet is Neptune.

As this planet is farthest from the Sun, cold winds blow here at very high speeds.
