Do not carry a lot of items when you want to present

Do not read from the screen.

Do not stand with your back to the audience.

Do not present a paragraph. Keep slides short and clear

Do not answer your phone. Keep it on silent

Do not speak with a mono-tone voice

Do not fold your arms. Be aware of body language

Do not read directly from your notes. Keep eye contact with your audience.

Dress Formal and be professional

Give hand outs to your audience.

Use clear text and diagrams for slides

Have good energy and smile to your audience

Keep good body language.
